- Great start to the year. If fundraising efforts continue, it may reduce amount being requested per family.
- Family kickball tournament is being planned tentatively for August 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Next requested contribution should be in September.

Fundraising: Johnnie

- Thank you to fundraising team for great start to the year! Six fundraisers are planned and some previous fundraisers being discontinued.
- There is a link on the website for feedback. Communication is important to success of the program so feedback is encouraged. Let us know if there is any confusion regarding expectations.
- Participation is expected unless there is a legitimate reason. The Coaches set the requirements. Please let the Coach know if you are not able to be at a function.
- Snapraise
  - \$19,221 raised. There is a fee charged by Snapraise which will reduce amount.
  - Prizes will be given to Pepsquad members based on having 5 or more contributions.
  - Concern was raised about the pressure felt by Pepsquad regarding the penalty for submitting emails by 10 pm on the night the fundraiser was started.
- OC Tri
  - We should receive \$1,000 based on 100 participants, but still waiting on final tally.
  - Comments regarding the event that it was a fun, rewarding service experience but it was slightly disorganized and it was held on a difficult weekend for the students because of prom.
- 4<sup>th</sup> of July Clinic (July 1<sup>st</sup> and July 4<sup>th</sup>)
  - Dance and cheer routines are taught to K-6 students. For \$50, they receive tshirt, food, poms, participation in parade. 25 sign-ups received. Hoping to have 60 participate.
