Check In on Day 1 8:30am-9:30am: Camp Begins at 10am / The first meal will be Lunch:

Teams may begin checking in, bring their luggage and get ready for Opening Ceremonies at 8:30am by entering through the side door entrance to the Sports Complex. There will be U.S. Spiritleaders Banners to indicate the correct entrance.

Release Forms...Students Will not be able to participate unless they have Insurance:

Each Coach/Advisor should bring all completed Release Forms to check-in before each camper can participate. Please make sure that the form is legible, the insurance carrier and policy number is listed and that a parent or guardian signs it. Students may be sent home if this form is not properly completed. This form can be downloaded online on the camp page of the website.

Parking for Check-In, During Camp and Closing Ceremonies for Coaches, Buses and Parents:

Parking will be available in the side lot to the Sports Complex. There is no fee for parking.

Team E-Z Ups and Tarps in the Sports Complex:

Each School is allowed two E-Z Ups in the Sports Complex. Each school will be assigned a side of the wall to place their two E-Z Ups. We are requesting that even though we are on basketball courts we would like you to bring tarps to put under the E-Z ups in case you plan on bringing tables or coolers to store drinks, food or snacks.

Team Water, Beverages and Snacks:

We are leaving it up to each coach to determine if they would like parents to drop off water, beverages and snacks throughout the duration of camp. We just ask that you plan the drop offs so they do not conflict with class instruction or the Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner caterers. Parents may only stay to watch on Evaluation Night or Closing Ceremonies. We also ask parents bring drawstring trash bags that students can put their trash in.

Luggage and Hotel Check In:

Each School's luggage will be placed near their E-Z Ups. At 7:30pm on Day 1, Schools will board their buses and be driven to their designated hotel for check in. A U.S. Spiritleaders staff person will be there to assign keys and help with the hotel check in process.

Catered Meals for Students and Adults: sapphirecatering.com:

We are very excited to have Sapphire Catering be a part of U.S. Spiritleaders. You may forward their website address so parents can read about Sapphire and how they provide meals to several Private Schools in Orange County area. Each coach will be sent the meal plans for each breakfast, lunch and dinner at camp. If any of your team members have any food allergies, you may fill out the form that will be also sent to you and send it us 4 days prior to camp.

What Coaches and Campers Should Bring To Camp: No Bedding, Towels and Less Clothing:

- Please remind your students that they do not need any Bedding, Towels, and the camp is now 3 days and not 4. We are suggesting that you tell your students the size of their luggage should be something that could be placed on the overhead bin of an airplane.
- The Sports Complex is not air conditioned but well ventilated. We have visited the Sports Complex during several times of the day and your students will work up a sweat while practicing.
- Practice/Team Workout Clothes and Shoes
- Water Bottles. Next Level Sports Complex has water faucets. Essentia Water Company will be providing water free of charge.
- Bring Sports tape. The EMT is only for medical emergencies and will not wrap or provide tape for campers.



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Performing At Camp: Stunt Groups, Evaluation, Spirit Spectacular, Home Routines, No Skits

-Evaluation Day 2: Many of the Cheer routines and formations are based on stunt groups. A front spot is not necessary but some visuals will be lost. Teams will be asked to select one camp routine to perform for evaluation on Day 2.

-Spirit Spectacular Day 3: All campers will perform the routines that they learned in their classes during Spirit Spectacular which takes place during our Closing Ceremonies.

-Optional Home Routines can also be performed at Closing Ceremonies. Individual Team routines can be up to 2 minutes. Combined Squad routines can be up to 5 minutes. Make sure that all music is recorded well on a Cell Phone/MP3 Player and is school and family appropriate.

Music Licensing and Camp Music: U.S. Spiritleaders follows the music licensing regulations that all camps and competitions must follow. We will inform you of these rules and provide you with the music on the first day of camp.

Spirit Sticks: will be awarded on Day 1, 2, and 3. from each squad. Your Buddy Instructor should check with you to find out their first and last name and if you approve of their nomination.

Best Decorated E-Z UPs. No more Best Decorated Rooms:

No decorations are allowed in the Hotel Rooms. Each school is responsible for any type of damage in any of the hotel rooms. We would like each school to decorate their E-Z Ups with this year's camp theme: All Sport Spirit...Let the Cheering Begin!

Day 2: Spirit Stomp/Rally Night...Remember Camp Begins at 9:00am The Spirit Stomp/Rally Night will follow immediately after classes on Day 2. Please bring any change of clothes, props, or give-aways with them from the hotel.

Pizza for Spirit Stomp/Rally Night on Day 2:

Pizza will be available to order for campers to eat during our Rally Night on Day 2. Order forms will be given to each coach at camp. Soda Drinks will also be available to order but due to the amount that is ordered we will not be able to guarantee that they will be cold.

Camp Souvenirs: Various souvenirs will be available on Day 3 at the Impact Apparel booth. Prices range from \$3.00 to \$60.00.

Commuter Teams: Meals, Allow For Traveling Time: Please be sure to call or e-mail the U.S. Spiritleaders office with your commuter information. i.e. are team members arriving each day by bus, parent transportation or driving of their own.

Evaluation and Closing Ceremonies and Information to Give to Parents and Guests:

It is very important that you have your parents read the Parent Information PDF form that we will have posted on our website. Guests will not be allowed in the U.S. Spiritleaders part of the Sports Complex until the following designated times:

Team Evaluations: Day 2 6:30pm

Spirit Spectacular/Closing Ceremonies: 2:30pm

-If parents wish to stand in line before these designated times, they must do so outside the Sports Complex.

-Only folding chairs that have floor protectors are allowed. No E-Z Ups or umbrellas are allowed.

-All snacks and trash must be picked up. Guests need to be prepared to pay for parking.

-All guests must be respectful to the staff and teams or they will be removed by security.
